

## History can be found anywhere...

...In an old barn, attic, or closet, and many times it happens when you least expect it. People are now passing down their heirlooms and the next generation is recognizing their importance. But this hasn't always been the case. There was a time when only "the modern" was in style and antiques were thrown out. People didn't perceive a value in these old pieces and often times their stories were long forgotten.



## This trunk is an example of a time gone by.

Emily Reed and her late husband, Ralph, were looking at houses here on San Juan Island in the late 1970's when they came across this trunk sitting in one of the old houses. Afraid that it would be thrown out, Ralph asked the owner if he could have it. The owner gladly handed it over and it has been a part of Emily's household ever since. The owner of the house didn't know its origin, but there was a letter inside the trunk from Frank Mullis, talking about Mr. Oakes, Did the trunk belong to Mr. Oakes? We'll never know, but it is a fun puzzle to try and figure out. Emily felt that this trunk was a part of San Juan Island history and always knew that she would donate it to the museum. She did this in August, and it is now on display in the Scribner Log Cabin.



If you have old photos, clothing or furniture in your family, remember to take the time to find out their history before the people who know it are gone. Talk to these "old timers", and more importantly, listen to them. They have many interesting stories to tell, and they are the keepers of our past. They hold the stories that give our artifacts and family heirlooms meaning.
